Laser Eye Treatment Clinics

Laser eye treatment is a conventional method of restoring eye sight for good and is an ideal solution if you have been wearing glasses for many years and are looking for a way to be independent of them.

Laser eye treatment is a medical procedure to counteract vision disorder and enhance proper viewing without glasses. This surgery can cure near sightedness, far sightedness and astigmatism.

Many laser eye treatment clinics offer two types of surgery:

- Photorefractive Keratectomy
- LASIK (Laser assisted in situ keratomileusis)

Photorefractive keratectomy, or PKR, is performed in an outpatient laser eye treatment clinic. In PKR, the cornea is reshaped by surgical removal of miniscule amount of tissues. Ultra violet beams are used to accomplish the task. Laser beams are then used to precisely extract the cornea's tissue. The success of this surgery is based on

the accuracy of removing tissues down to billionths of an inch. It is a less than 15 minutes procedure and the patient is good to go back to daily chores in a day or two.

The second type of eye treatment surgery is LASIK. An acronym for Laser Assisted In situ Keratomileusis, this procedure is also performed in a laser eye treatment clinic. A complicated but efficient procedure, it is aimed to improve eye sight significantly and is more applicable for patients with difficult refractive corrections. A surgical incision is made on the cornea, the laser is used to remove the tissues and the cornea is pulled back. This allows the light to focus precisely on the retina. The entire procedure takes around 5 minutes only.

There are many laser eye treatment clinics in almost every area. Due to high competition, the prices may differ variably. Of course, a good reputable institute will charge more than a private practice of an ophthalmologist.

A round figure for the procedure from any laser eye treatment clinic is around \$2000 for each eye. This is a standard cost but geographical locations, the particular eye specialist, taxes and royalty fees for surgeons are some variables that may affect the typical price.

Additional cost might be incurred which includes follow up treatments, post surgery medications in case of any

complications.

Some laser eye treatment clinics offer discounts to senior citizens above 65 years of age. Other ophthalmologists might give discounts to patients who pay in cash rather than arrange financing.

A good laser eye treatment clinic is very essential. The most favorable clinic should be the one within reach and which offers a good discount. But eye matters are sensitive and worthy of attention. Opting for a practitioner at cheaper rates might result in greater costs in the future. Complications and prolonged side effects can be a major discomfort ranging from infections to loss of visual quality.

Overall laser eye treatment is a great option for people who are tired of glasses and irritated by contact lenses. It is an easy and effective procedure and is also relatively inexpensive compared to a great deal of other surgeries.
